10/07/21 – 330 S Spruce – unk person siphoning fuel from vehicle left hose in tank and poured on ground.

10/31/21 – 1455 S McKinley, Kum & Go – 5 gals of fuel from over fill of vehicle, CFD responded

12/07/21 – 1455 S McKinley, Kum & Go – large fuel spill, unknown how long it had been running, around the side of the building from the pump, CFD responded.

12/08/21 – 4651 W. Yellowstone – Maverik- 20 to 30 gallons of fuel spilled. MFD responded.
